Rules for "Making your Own Instrument" Contest

- 1- Build an instrument out of regular household materials. You do not have to invent a new instrument, but try to be creative and make something interesting.
- 2- The instrument can't be bought as a single piece (no kits).
- 3- It has to be made with homemade materials (pvc pipes, strings, wood pieces, rubber bands, etc).
- 4- A presentation about your instrument must last 5-10 minutes. During this time, you may talk about the materials you used as well as the steps involved in making the instrument. You must also give a musical performance, playing an actual song with the instrument you built.
- 5- Both the presentation of the instrument and the instrument itself will be judged. Your overall score will count as the grade of the third test.
- 6- The teacher and your colleagues will grade your presentation and instrument on a scale of 1-10.
- 7- The ballots will be cast anonymously in a box after each presentation.
- 8- The grade will be the average of the collected scores with weights 60% students, 40% teacher.
