ACTM Fast-Track Bachelor's + Master's TMGT Degree Program Goals

- Accelerate time to completion of MS as compared to separate Bachelor's & Master's programs taken back-to-back.
 - Reduces total time by one semester and total SCH by 6 hours.
- Enhance marketability of Bachelor's & Master's programs in Tech Management.
- Strengthen pipeline of Bachelor's TMGT students continuing into MS TMGT program.
- Create ACTM Fast Track Bachelor's+Master's TMGT degree program allowing undergraduate students in an undergraduate Technology Management program to begin coursework towards the M.S. in Technology Management during their senior year at East Texas A&M University.



ACTM Fast-Track Bachelor's + Master's TMGT Degree Program Background

- The ACTM Fast-Track BS+MS TMGT degree program was introduced in the Fall 2024 semester providing a seamless path from the B.S. Technology Management program into the M.S. in Technology Management.
- Two students were admitted to the new ACTM Fast-Track BS+MS TMGT degree program in Spring 2025 and began prescribed program coursework in the Fall 2025 semester.
- Next step: Offer similar option to students in the university's Bachelor of Applied Arts & Sciences (B.A.A.S.) in Technology Management program.



- An ACTM Fast-Track program proposal, patterned after the BS+MS TMGT program, was created for the B.A.A.S. TMGT program and submitted as a curriculum change request in October 2025 for Fall 2026 implementation.
- Students can earn both B.A.A.S. and M.S. degrees in approximately three and a half years at ETAMU upon completion of the requirements for each degree. (If prescribed course schedule is followed.)
- In the senior year of their undergraduate degree, Fast-Track BAAS+MS program candidates take 28 credit hours from required undergraduate and graduate core courses.
- Six credit hours of graduate courses are counted for both BAAS and MS degrees.



Lessons learned from previous implementation of BS+MS Fast-track TMGT program.


- Undergraduate students cannot receive financial aid for graduate level courses.
 - Courses offered as 500-level (grad-level) in BS+MS program will be offered as 400-level (senior-level) courses cross-listed to their corresponding 500-level courses.
- One course taken as 500-level in Senior year. Student must petition for approval to take graduate course during senior year.
- Window for applications reduced from 75-90 hours to 60 hours.



ACTM Fast-Track BAAS+MS TMGT Degree Program Progression

- Students in the B.A.A.S. TMGT Program enter with an Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in a technical field from a regionally accredited Community/Junior College.
- 2+2+1 model (152 SCH total taken vs. 158 SCH in separate programs):
 - AAS Up to 85 hours transferred in from completed technical A.A.S. degree with minimum 2.50 GPA.
 - BAAS 37 upper-level hours at ETAMU (120 hours minimum for Bachelor's, 122 actual hours taken)
 - MS 36 Graduate-level hours at ETAMU (6 hours counted for both BAAS & MS)
- Pursue articulation agreements ultimately leading to M.S. degree.
- Incentivize students in the [High School? to] Community College to University pipeline to continue their academic journey through a graduate degree.
